
HISTORY

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE PROCESS

DWA PLLC takes pride in the quality of any and all documents that come out of our office and the offices of our consultant team. We believe that this process starts internally with the proper checks and balances between team members and staff. Our management staff works closely with both the Project Managers and the Production Team to ensure that our contract documents reflect the design intent promised to the client. We are a small to medium size firm in which all team members are involved in multiple project facets. We are a true studio environment in which all team members will be involved on the project from start to finish, ensuring that the design and documents are executed properly.

During the Schematic Design, Design Development, and Construction Document phases of a project DWA and our consultant teams will issue progress packages in incremental stages equal to the level of complexity of the project. A standard project will be issued in phased completion levels of 30%, 60%, 90% and 100% documents. At each phased submittal, the project manager in direct control of the production team will review the package and provide feedback in the form of "redline comments". Once these comments have been addressed the Project manager will review the submittal again prior to providing it to the Principal or Partner in-charge for any final comments prior to issuing the documents to the client.

In the last 5 years DWA has taken the QAQC process a step further by implementing the use of Autodesk Revit software. Revit is software that allows our projects to be developed in a BIM format. The implementation of BIM as a standard in our office allows our team to view any project in full 3D and provide the design team a realistic feeling of the proposed space. In the last year DWA has also implemented the use of Oculus Virtual Reality headsets in our office for clients to experience the space during Schematic design. Revit is not only used for a visualization tool, it is also used to save our clients money and time. By using Revit, the same model used to create the preliminary renderings is the model used to develop the Design Development and Construction Document drawings.


DWA uses Master Format Specifications and is capable of providing electronically developed specifications based on this software if needed and included in the scope of work.


CONSULTANT QUALITY ASSURANCE PROCESS

Coordination with consultants is critical to any successful project. DWA implements the use of Revit and BIM software to help provide support for changes made in the field along with the ability to find and coordinate any discrepancies between disciplines. The process is done by merging the individual discipline models into one master model held by the DWA team.

In addition to BIM support and software, DWA typically holds weekly conference calls with the project ownership team and consultant teams. Once construction starts the general contractor is included on the calls to ensure that any questions or concerns are addressed quickly. The projects that don't require weekly conference calls are on a bi-weekly schedule. Our team prides itself on making sure that we are available **ANYTIME**, day or night, for our clients.
